Feedback of the different faculties of Arts, Commerce and Science was collected online with the help of Google forms. Total 19 faculty members recorded their response regarding infrastructural and academic development of the college. The form was divided in two sections one on curriculum based and another from different College Administration and Infrastructural development. The overall structure of the feedback was the rating from 1(Strongly Disagree) to 5 (Strongly Agree) on different aspects. There were 35 questions framed on the impact of curriculum, College Administration and Infrastructural development.
