Title: Student Welfare Scheme

Objectives:

1. The students should not be deprived of education due to their financial problems.
2. Giving equal opportunity to student of taking education despite of its financial background.
3. Financial help to medically sick students in major diseases.

The Context:

The Gramgeeta Mahavidyalaya Chimur has introduced the Student Welfare Fund scheme during the 2022-2023 academic year, under the leadership of the Honorable President and Principal. Both teaching and non-teaching staff members contributing to the fund annually, respectively 500 rupees and 300 rupees. The management provide valuable guidance each year on how to best utilize the Student Welfare Fund to assist financially deprived students, particularly those facing medical challenges such as cancer. The fund is distributed to eligible students in need of financial assistance.

The Practice:

- To offer financial assistance to needy students, applications are invited through notices that are circulated with the Principal's approval. The committee members carefully evaluate students from various branches and select those who are financially deprived and have a regular attendance record for the scheme. The application process requires faculty recommendations and interview conducted by the committee member to finalize the list of eligible students. The financial assistance is intended to address fundamental needs such as bus passes, uniform and notebooks. It is expected that the selected students will utilize the fund for these essential requirements.
- During the academic session 2022-2023, a total of 6900 Rs. was collected by the Student Welfare Committee. In response to the Covid-19 pandemic and its financial impact on students, the committee decided to extend a helping hand to those who were unable to pay the admission fees of purchase college uniforms. Specially, ten deserving students

were identified by the committee and selected to receive free admission and college uniforms.

- To achieve this objective the Student Welfare Committee allocated the collected funds towards providing financial assistance to these selected students. The committee's decision to prioritize these students for financial aid was a testament to their commitment to improving the welfare of all students. By providing free admission and uniforms, the committee ensured that these ten students had equal opportunities to learn and participate in college activities without any financial burden. Overall, the fund allocation report for the academic session 2022-2023 demonstrated the Student Welfare Committee's dedication to supporting the needs of the student body during a challenging time.
- During the academic session of 2022-23, Ku. Nargis Ramjan sheikh, a first-year B.Sc. student to help in B Sc. 1ST Year admissions. In response to her situation, the Student Welfare Committee took an initiative to provide her with financial aid. As a result, a sum of Rs. 600 (Six Hundred) was handed over to her by the Principal, Dr. Amir Dhamani, and the convener of the Student Welfare Committee, Mr. Samirkumar Bhelave, in the form of a check also one of the another student named as Ku. Mayuri Dayarm Chaudhari, B. Sc. First Year. In response to her Medical Treatment for injured during zoology practical situation, the Student Welfare Committee took an initiative to provide her with financial aid. As a result, a sum of Rs. 2238 (Two Thausands Two Hundred Thirty eight rupees) was handed over to her by the Principal, Dr. Amir Dhamani, and the convener of the Student Welfare Committee, Mr. Samirkumar Bhelave, in the form of a check. The Gramgeeta institute is committed to assisting financially deprived and disadvantaged students, covering their admission fees, exam fees, and other essential needs. The welfare of all students is of utmost importance to the college. The committee expresses its sincere wishes for Ku. Nargis Ramjan sheikh and Ku. Mayuri Dayarm Chaudhari early recovery and a happier life ahead.
