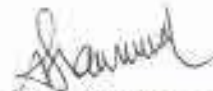

A) NSS Regular Activities during the session are as follows:

1. Birth Anniversary of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar -

On 14th April, 2021, the 130th Birth Anniversary of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar was celebrated in the Gramgeeta Mahavidyalaya, Chimur. The event was presided by the Principal, Dr. Amir A. Dhamani, all the teaching and non-teaching staff were present during the program. The incomparable work of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar for the Nation and the deprived section of the society was remembered during the event. Covid-19 rules and regulations were strictly followed during the activity.

2. World Environmental Day-

On 5th June, 2021, the world Environment Day was celebrated in the Mahavidyalaya. This year the theme for the World Environment Day was 'Ecosystem Restoration'. It is celebrated to remind people about the importance of Nature and to raise awareness and generate action on a pressing environmental issue. - b) **Duration:** 25th March to 31st March 2022.
- c) **Students Participation:** Male- 22, Female- 28, Total- 50

Camp Activities: -

I. Inauguration of Camp-

The inauguration of NSS Special Camp was held on 26th March 2022, at Z. P. Upper Primary School, Tekepar. The event was presided by our Honourable Principal Dr. Amir A. Dhamani and inaugurated by Shri. Omprakash Ganorkar (Ex. Sarpanch, Grampanchayat, Tekepar). As a chief guest, Sau. Vachhalatai Warkhede (Sarpanch, Grampanchayat, Tekepar), Shri. C. M. Meshram (Gramsevak, Tekepar), Shri. Kuradkar Sir (Headmaster, Z.P.U.P.S., Tekepar), Prof. Dr. Sandeep Satao, Prof. Humeshwar Anande and Prof. Mrunal Warhade were present. Villagers, Volunteers, all teaching and non-teaching staff of Gramgeeta Mahavidyalaya, Chimur were also present during the event.

II. Projects Completed during the Camp-

1. Reformation of damaged ways to the farm-

Several ways to farm were found damaged which creating difficulties for the villagers to use it. Volunteers repaired it by putting soil and grits on them.

2. Soak pit Construction-

At several places in the village, the sewage water from bathrooms were found flowing on the road. So, volunteers constructed Soak pit there.

3. Sludge Removal from Drain-

At number of places, the drains were found full of sludge which choked the drain. During the Camp period, volunteers removed this sludge from the drain.

4. Latrine Construction-

Camp participants helped few villagers to construct their latrine.

5. Cleaning of Water bodies-

The lake near the School in the Tekepar village was found polluted and solid wastes were found spread over. Volunteers collected and removed all such wastes from the water body and disposed them.

6. Construction of rough drains-

To drain sewage water out of the village residential area, rough drains were constructed.

7. Cleanliness Campaign-

At every morning during the camp, volunteers run cleanliness campaign in the village along with the villagers.

8. Weir Construction-

A small weir was constructed using soil, sand and stone across a channel whose water used to flow over agricultural field and few houses causing damages to them.

III. Students Developmental Programs-

For the physical and intellectual development of the volunteers participated in the camp and the youth generation of the village, various program has been organised.

1. Running and exercise session at 05:00 am in the morning.
2. Yoga training and practice under the guidance of 'Patanjali Yoga Samiti, Chimur'.
3. Community Prayer and meditation at the evening session at 06:30 pm under the guidance of Shri. Sureshji Dodke and Shri. Yogesh Ramgunde of 'Gurudev Seva Mandal, Tekepar'.

IV. Cultural Programs-

At the evening, 08:30 onwards, various cultural programs have been organised. Villagers were awakened and entertained through various programs like singing, dancing, drama, play, mimicry, street play etc. Public awareness was done on various topics like Environmental protection, Forest and Soil conservation, Personal hygiene, Village Cleanliness, Agricultural development, Water conservation, Rain Water Harvesting etc., through street play and drama. All these activities helped to unleash the hidden talents in camp participants and to awaken the villagers.

V. Intellectual Programs-

On afternoon session, intellectual programs were organised during the camp. Number of guests were invited for guest lectures on various topics.

- On 28th March 2022, guests were invited to talk on “***Farm Management and Village Development***”. The event was presided by Sau. Vachhalatai Warkhede (Sarpanch, Tekepar). Mr. Moreshwar Zade (*Krushibhushan*) and Prof.
